Course Description:

This course on the hotly debated, often misinterpreted and sadly neglected part of the Bible, intends at promoting biblical literacy among the committed participants (parishioners and non-parishioners), dispelling the misunderstanding, confusion, and fear often associated with the reading of the book. It aims at empowering the learners to embrace the essential message of the last book of the Bible, that is: to serve God and Christ faithfully in the midst of a hostile pagan society that exults power, wealth, and pleasure; and to live out Revelation's spirituality of resistance, hope and liberation. The study will do exegetical analysis of the Apocalypse aided by secondary texts from historical, literary, ethical, and theological perspectives. In its exploration, each unit of the text under study is examined with the following guide questions: What is its contextual meaning? What does it say and teach? How was it received and interpreted (or misinterpreted) in the Church, society, culture, and the arts through the centuries? What does the Catholic Church teach about it today? and, What should I do and how do I apply it in life? Leading biblical literacy flow into biblical spirituality, it is the aim of this course to let the participants know, follow, and worship more deeply the God and the Lamb revealed to John of Patmos.
