JUNE 12, 2016

Reflection

Today's Gospel shows the delicate relationship between forgiveness and love. First of all, this whole meal was a set up to trap Jesus. The Pharisee invited Jesus to a meal. Meals were normally divided into two parts in that time. During the first part the host would have appetizers spread around, and the guests would be made ready to eat the supper, they would be purified, and massaged, and deodorized from their long trip to the home where the dinner was. This would traditionally be done by servants, male ones or by widows.

Simon, the Pharisee, makes no attempt to keep out the sinful woman. In fact, it seems that everyone knew she was somehow sinful. For a sinful woman to approach another Jew, she would have to be purified or she would cause the person she touched to need purification. Allowing this woman in, and allowing her to be the one who perfumed and washed Jesus was very insulting and was obviously a test, which Simon thinks Jesus has failed. He purposely did not tell him the background of the woman and so it was all a set up. Simon figured that if Jesus was really a prophet he could see through the charade and know she was sinful. Jesus just lets it happen. Knowing it was a test, Jesus then tests Simon. He asks him a simple question with an obvious and simple answer to it. If a creditor was owed \$5000 and another was owed \$50,000 and both were forgiven the debt, who would love and respect the creditor the most? It is an easy answer, one that we would have no trouble with understanding today as well. The one who got forgiven the most money would love him the most!

Jesus then applies this little question and answer to let the Pharisee see things in a different way. The fact that the woman carried out in more than an adequate matter all of the polite and expected cultural things that should be done at a meal, and the host did not, showed that the woman loved and respected Jesus more than Simon the Pharisee did. That she had sinned more than the Pharisee, seems to be a given, but in being forgiven, she will have much more to be thankful for, and will have much more love for Jesus. The Pharisees who



saw themselves as fulfilling all the Laws, have little to be 'forgiven' for, but because they show no love or respect and probably have not asked for forgiveness, then they will get none.

Ask God for forgiveness, and do it out of love and respect, and you will be forgiven. Jesus has given us the means for this to happen, the Eucharist and the sacrament of Reconciliation. We have merely to ask in good faith, as Paul indicates, and we shall receive. This week let us reflect on our own misgivings and sins, and try to understand how they have hurt God, and then let us ask true forgiveness for ourselves and, being forgiven, make sure that we forgive others too.

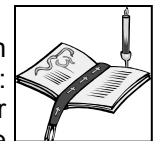
Annual Baby Shower

La lectura del Santo Evangelio en esta semana de Tiempo Ordinario nos cuenta la hermosa historia de la respuesta de Jesús a la mujer pecadora. En su amor por Jesús, ella pasó por alto la forma en que los invitados eran tratados en los banquetes. Ella lavó los pies de Jesús con sus lágrimas, después con aceite perfumado los secó con sus cabellos. Simón, el anfitrión, no mostró la usual cortesía con Jesús cuando Él llegó. Sin embargo, condenó a Jesús por asociarse con la mujer que era una conocida pecadora. Al contar la historia de la deuda perdonada a Simón, Jesús alabó a la mujer. A ella se le perdonó mucho porque amó mucho. Jesús señala la necesidad que tiene Simón de perdonar? por su falta de hospitalidad, su falta de respeto a cada uno de ellos y su egoísmo. Esta historia es un poderoso ejemplo de la relación entre el amor y el perdón.

¿Cómo tratas a tus amigos? ¿Discriminas algunas veces contra alguien que es diferente? ¿Qué pasaría si Dios actuara de la misma forma con nosotros?

¿Cuál es la medida de tu amor? ¿Dónde está en la escala con relación a aceptar a todas las personas? ¿Tienes distinciones, como Simón, y dices: "Esta persona es lo suficientemente buena"? ¿Cuándo alguien te ofende eres capaz de perdonar o guardas rencor? ¿Cómo vas a mostrar que aceptas a todo el mundo? ¿Qué haces para animar a tus amigos a tener una actitud de perdón?

Aún en nuestros días hay personas que se arrepienten de sus pecados por miedo al castigo y al infierno. El verdadero arrepentimiento es dictado por el amor. En el caso de que nuestro arrepentimiento no sea muy profundo o eficaz tenemos que preguntarnos si en verdad nuestro amor a Dios es profundo y eficaz.

Esta semana te invitamos a que hagas un examen de conciencia y reflexiones en los pecados que has cometido y la forma como estos han ofendido a Dios. Pídele perdón a Dios de corazón a través del Sacramento de la reconciliación, al hacerlo y ser perdonados y absueltos, perdona también aquellos que te han ofendido.
