## Reflection Corner

The Lord's prayer is truly the summary of the whole gospel. "Since the Lord after handing over the practice of prayer, said elsewhere, "Ask and you will receive," and since everyone has petitions which are peculiar to his circumstances, the regular and appropriate prayer – The Lord's Prayer is said first, as the foundation of further desires. St. Augustine made this comment – "Run through all the words of the holy prayers in the Bible and I do not think that you will find anything in them that is not contained and included in the Lord's Prayer. The Lord's prayer is the most perfect of prayers. St. Thomas Aquinas wrote that in the Lord's Prayer we ask not only for all the things we can rightly desire, but also in the sequence that they should be desired. This prayer not only teaches us to ask for things but also in what order we should desire them. The Sermon on the Mount is teaching for life, the Our Father is a prayer; but in both the one and the other the Spirit of the Lord gives new form to our desires, those inner movements that animate our lives. Jesus teaches us this new life by His words; He teaches us to ask for it by our prayer. The rightness of our life in Him will depend on the rightness of our prayer.

The prayer that comes to us from Jesus is truly unique: it is "of the Lord". On the one hand, in the words of this prayer the only Son gives us the words the Father gave Him: He is the Master of our prayer. On the other, as Word Incarnate, He knows in his human heart the needs of his human brothers and sisters and reveals them to us: He is the model of our prayer. Jesus not only gives us the words of our filial prayer; at the same time He give us the Spirit by whom these words become in us 'spirit and life". Even more, the proof and possibility of our filial prayer is that the Father "sent the Spirit of His Son into our hearts, crying 'Abba! Father!' Since our prayer sets forth our desires before God, it is again the Father, "who searches the hearts of men," who "knows what is the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for the saints according to the will of God". The prayer to Our Father is inserted into the mysterious mission of the Son and of the Spirit. Before we make our

own this first exclamation of the Lord's Prayer, we must humbly cleanse our hearts of certain false images drawn "from this world". *Humility* makes us recognize that "no one knows the Son except the Father, and no one knows the Father except the Son and anyone to whom the Son chooses to reveal Him," that is, "to little children". The purification of our hearts has to do with paternal or maternal images, stemming from our personal and cultural history, and influencing our relationship with God. God, Our Father transcends the categories of the created world. To impose our own ideas in this area "upon him" would be to fabricate idols to adore or pull down. To pray to the Father is to enter into His mystery as He is and as the Son has revealed Him to us.

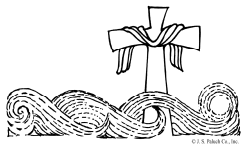

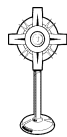

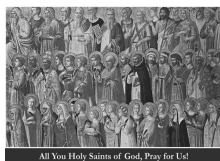

#### Vet your child's summer sleep-away camp



For many children, summer sleep-away camps are great adventures that become cherished memories. But for parents, the concern of sexual abuse is one that needs to be addressed. Before enrolling your child in a summer camp, consider staff reputation and screening practices. Ask questions about how the camp screens counselors and workers who will have access to your children (cafeteria workers, cooks, maintenance staff, etc.). Ask about any problems they may have handled previously, or how they would handle a complaint from a child. Get all the information you need to be comfortable before you send your child off for a few weeks of fun. ## **Mensaje para Reflexionar**

### **Señor, enséñanos a orar...**

Es significativo que la instrucción que Jesús nos ha dejado en la lectura del Evangelio de este domingo, siga inmediatamente al episodio de Marta y María, que concluye con la sentencia de Jesús: «Hay necesidad de pocas cosas, o mejor, de una sola». Esa única cosa necesaria es la oración. Jesús nos enseña personalmente que la oración debe ser perseverante y confiada. Las palabras y las instrucciones de Jesús están motivadas por la petición de uno de sus discípulos. Pero esta petición no habría sido formulada si sus discípulos no hubieran visto antes a Jesús mismo orando. En efecto, el Evangelio dice: «Sucedió que, estando él orando en cierto lugar...». Ver orar a un santo cualquiera o a un hombre de Dios es un espectáculo maravilloso; pero ver orar a Cristo mismo debió ser sobrecogedor. Viendo orar a Jesús, este discípulo ha comprendido algo muy importante: la oración es algo que se aprende y, para hacer progresos en ella, es necesario tener un maestro que tenga experiencia en el tema. Todos hemos oído que multitudes seguían a Santa Bernardita cuando ella, movida por un impulso interior irresistible, corría a la gruta cercana a Lourdes a la cita con la celestial Señora. La gente no veía nada. Pero valía la pena levantarse al alba con lluvia y frío tan solo para verla a ella orar.

Cuando Jesús oraba nadie se habría atrevido a interrumpir su diálogo con el Padre. Pero «cuando terminó», los discípulos le expresan su anhelo de compartir esa misma experiencia: «Enséñanos a orar». Y Jesús satisface este deseo enseñándonos su oración: «Cuando oréis, decid: Padre, santificado sea tu Nombre, venga tu Reino...». Muchos santos y místicos han compuesto hermosas oraciones. Para comprender la suprema belleza de ésta, bastaría detenerse en la primera palabra: «Padre». Aquí está contenida toda la experiencia de Cristo y toda su enseñanza.

En este domingo le pedimos al Señor que nos enseñe a hacer realidad, esa nueva relación que debemos tener con Él, o sea que lo consideremos como lo que por otra parte le decimos todos los días: Padre nuestro. Se lo pedimos al Señor, especialmente para nosotros, para los que estamos aquí, y lo hacemos al tiempo que recordamos a todos los que sufren, a los enfermos, o a los que están solos o a los que necesitan de nosotros.
